Jackson, a world famous plastic surgeon. In addition, Ohio Plastic Surgeon Dr. Simman completed a Burn Fellowship followed by a Research Fellowship at the State University of New York at Stony Brook. He is an Associate Professor with the Department of Surgery and the Department of Pharmacology & Toxicology at Wright State University.

As an active clinician and researcher, Dr. Simman's work has been published in numerous major journals, including Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery, Annals of Plastic Surgery, Aesthetics of Plastic Surgery, The Journal of Craniofacial Surgery, Wounds, Academic Emergency Medicine, and others. Dr. Simman is an Associate Clinical Professor at the Wright State University Boonshoft School of Medicine and currently serves as President of the American College of Certified Wound Specialists (ACCWS).
